Fictitious Firm Name Certificates

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to NRS 602.035 that the Eureka County Commissioners did on September 5, 2014 pass an Ordinance amending the Eureka County Code by creating provisions relating to certification and renewal of certification for fictitious business names. Every person doing business in Eureka County under an assumed name, that is in any way different from the legal name of each person who owns an interest in the business, or in the case of an artificial person, its name as it appears in the records of the secretary of state, must file a certificate containing the information required by Nevada Revised Statutes 602.020 with the County Clerk. A certificate filed with the County Clerk expires five (5) years after the date it is filed or within six (6) months of the effective date of this ordinance, whichever is later. A renewal certificate filed with the County Clerk expires after five (5) years. The fee for filing a fictitious firm renewal is the same as the original filing of \$20.00. Fictitious Firm Name forms can be found on the Clerk/Treasurer page of the Eureka County website www.co.eureka.nv.us or can be obtained at the Eureka County Clerk/Treasurer's office in the Eureka County Courthouse.
