

Eureka County residents can now register to vote and make changes to their current voter registration profile through a website <a href="https://www.registertovotenv.gov">www.registertovotenv.gov</a> the online system of the Secretary of State's website.

To utilize the online system, citizens need to be at least 18 years old and have a Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) driver's license or a DMV issued identification card.

Registered voters can access their voting information at <a href="https://www.nvsos.gov/votersearch">www.nvsos.gov/votersearch</a> by entering their first and last names, date of birth and driver's license number or social security number. From there, they can update their address or change their party affiliation without completing a paper application and submitting it to the Eureka County Clerk's Office.

Eligible voters who are presently registered in another Nevada county but living in Eureka County may now register with the online voter system, which is federally funded by the Help America Vote Act.

Residents have until Sunday, October 7, 2012 to register online to vote in the November 6, 2012 General Election.
