

**NOTICE OF CLOSE OF REGISTRATION FOR 2018 GENERAL
ELECTION**

In All Precincts, in Eureka County, State of Nevada, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to NRS 293.560 for the close of registration for the 2018 General Election to be held on November 6, 2018.

Mail-in voter registration applications or updated voter registrations MUST be postmarked on or before Tuesday, October 9, 2018.

From Sunday, October 7th through Tuesday, October 16th , an elector may register to vote or update a current voter registration only:

- By appearing in person at the office of the Eureka County Clerk at 10 S. Main Street, Eureka, Nevada. A Nevada DMV issued photo ID card or driver's license is required for new registrations. If the current residence is not indicated on the ID, additional proof will be required. If you do not have a Nevada DMV issued photo ID card or driver's license, you may register by providing the last four digits of your Social Security Number.

On or before October 18th, an elector may register to vote online:

- Eligible voters can register or update their voter registration information online at nvsos.gov. A Nevada DMV issued photo ID card or driver's license is required.

Extended hours on October 15th and 16th are: 8:00 am to 7:00 pm
