

HOW TO VOTE ON A TOUCH SCREEN VOTING MACHINE

INSERT your activation card in the yellow slot on the bottom left of the voting machine.



TOUCH CIRCLE next to your choice and a green check mark will appear.

TO CHANGE YOUR VOTE touch the same circle again, then the circle for the choice you want.

CONTINUE to the following page by touching NEXT or BACK to return to the previous screen.




REVIEW your choices at any time by touching the REVIEW square.



PRINT paper record of your ballot selections by touching the yellow square at end of ballot.

The printout stays on the machine and is used for audit purposes.



To make changes on your ballot. To cast your ballot.

RETURN YOUR ACTIVATION CARD to an election worker after ballot is cast and the voting machine ejects it.

GENERAL INFORMATION

If you need to contact the Election Department, you can do so by calling (775) 237-5262; fax (775) 237-6015.

First-time voters: Bring your **IDENTIFICATION and proof of residency** if you registered to vote by mail or did not provide identification or proof of residency at time of registration.

Assistance will be available for voters if needed; ask an election worker for assistance. Reasonable accommodations will be made to help any voter requesting assistance at a polling place. [NRS 293.565(11)]

Every polling place has a voting machine that can enlarge the screen on the voting machine and supports audio voting. Reasonable accommodations will be made to help any voter requesting assistance at a polling place. (NRS 293.565(11))

WARNING: A person who is entitled to vote shall not vote or attempt to vote more than once at the same election. Any person who votes or attempts to vote more than once at the same election is guilty of a Category D Felony and shall be punished as provided in NRS 193.130. [Per NRS 293.780]

If you would like to request an absent ballot, you must submit your request in writing to the Clerk's Office no later than Tuesday, June 7. Absent ballot request forms can be obtained by calling the number listed above.

If you requested an absent ballot, you must return your voted ballot to the Clerk's Office no later than 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.
