## **CALL TO ORDER**

The Liquor Board met pursuant to law on June 20, 2011, in the Commissioners' meeting room at the Eureka County Courthouse, 10 S. Main St., Eureka, Nevada. Present were: Chairman Mike Page, Vice Chairman Jim Ithurralde, Member Leonard Fiorenzi, Member Ted Beutel (District Attorney), Member Ken Jones (Sheriff), and Clerk & Treasurer Jackie Berg. Chairman Page called the meeting to order at 9:15 a.m.

## **APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Sheriff Jones motioned to approve the agenda notice as posted; Member Fiorenzi seconded the motion; motion carried 5-0.

## **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Sheriff Jones motioned to approve the minutes of the April 6, 2011, Liquor Board meeting; Member Ithurralde seconded the motion; motion carried 5-0.

## **LIQUOR LICENSES**

New License Applications: Sheriff Jones reported that no applications for new licenses were pending.

Special Event Licenses: Sheriff Jones stated that a question was raised regarding whether the liquor license for Eureka Lion's Club had been renewed at the last meeting. A review of the minutes showed that the license had not been renewed. Michael Mears attended on behalf of the Lion's Club and stated due to a misunderstanding, the Lion's Club license had been relinquished, but the membership now desired to renew it for a 4<sup>th</sup> of July event. The Liquor Board informed him that once a license is cancelled it cannot be renewed, so the Lion's Club would have to go through the application process to reinstate the license. The only license they were eligible for in time for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July would be a Special Events License. District Attorney Ted Beutel motioned to approve a Special Events License for the Eureka Lion's Club contingent upon the Sheriff's review and approval of the license application; Member Fiorenzi seconded the motion; motion carried 4-0; Member Ithurralde abstained since he was a member of the Lion's Club.

VFW Post 8194 applied for a Special Events License for the VFW Softball Tournament scheduled July 30 & 31, 2011. Member Fiorenzi motioned to approve the Special Events License for VFW Post 8194; District Attorney Ted Beutel seconded the motion; motion carried 3-0; Sheriff Jones and Member Ithurralde abstained since they are members of the VFW Post.

Quarterly Renewals: Sheriff Jones presented the list of quarterly license renewals. Member Ithurralde motioned to approve the quarterly renewals as presented; Member Fiorenzi seconded the motion; motion carried 5-0.
