

ORDINANCE NO. 15-002

**SUMMARY:** AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF EUREKA COUNTY, STATE OF NEVADA, TO AMEND THE JULY 2014 EDITION OF THE EUREKA COUNTY CODE, BY ADDING A NEW TITLE, TITLE 17, EUREKA COUNTY COMPTROLLER, AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

**TITLE:** THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE 2015 EUREKA COUNTY COMPTROLLER ORDINANCE.

The Board of Commissioners of Eureka County, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, does hereby ordain:

The 2014 Eureka County Code is hereby amended pursuant to the procedural requirements of N.R.S. 244.095 and N.R.S. 244.100 by adding a new title, Title 17, Eureka County Comptroller. The Ordinance shall hereafter read as follows:

Chapter 10 - COMPTROLLER; APPOINTMENT; DUTIES; SALARY

.010 Appointment

The position of Comptroller is hereby created. The Comptroller serves at the pleasure of the Board of County Commissioners.

.020 Duties

The Comptroller is the chief fiscal officer of the County and shall perform all the duties required of county auditors and comptrollers under Nevada Revised Statute chapter 251, or any other applicable law of the State of Nevada, and ordinances contained in the Eureka County Code. All references in the County Code or elsewhere to the Eureka County Recorder/Auditor performing the duties of a fiscal officer, auditor, processing accounts payable and payroll, maintaining personnel records, or performing the duties of budget director, are hereby of no more force and effect. These duties (chief fiscal officer, auditor, accounts payable, payroll, personnel records, and budget director) are hereby assigned to the comptroller.

.030 Salary

The Comptroller's salary shall be fixed by the Board.

Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption and publication as provided by Nevada Revised Statutes Chapters 244.
