

ORDINANCE NO. 15-001

**SUMMARY:** AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF EUREKA COUNTY, STATE OF NEVADA, TO AMEND THE JULY 2014 EDITION OF THE EUREKA COUNTY CODE, TITLE 16, EUREKA COUNTY JUSTICE COURTS, BY REVISION, MODIFICATION AND EXTENSION, BY AMENDING TITLE 16, TO ESTABLISH ONE UNIFIED JUSTICE COURT WITH TWO DEPARTMENTS IN EUREKA COUNTY, AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

**TITLE:** THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE 2015 EUREKA COUNTY JUSTICE COURT ORDINANCE.

The Board of Commissioners of Eureka County, a political subdivision of the State of Nevada, does hereby ordain:

The 2014 Eureka County Code is hereby amended pursuant to the procedural requirements of N.R.S. 244.095 and N.R.S. 244.100. Title 16, Eureka County Justice Courts, shall hereafter read as follows:

Chapter 10 - ESTABLISHMENT, DEPARTMENTS, TOWNSHIP  
BOUNDARIES, and JUSTICE OF THE PEACE

.010 Establishment and Departments

There is hereby established one Justice Court within Eureka County, known as the Eureka County Justice Court, with two departments, known as the “Eureka County Justice Court, Beowawe” and the “Eureka County Justice Court, Eureka” departments.

.020 Township boundaries

By N.R.S. 1.050(3) and N.R.S. 4.360, Justice Courts shall be held in their respective townships. The township is defined by the Board of County Commissioners pursuant to N.R.S. 257.010.

- A. The township boundary for the Eureka County Justice Court shall be the entirety of the County of Eureka.
- B. The jurisdiction of the two departments of the Eureka County Justice Court shall be identical, in that any matter within the jurisdiction of the Eureka County Justice Court may be filed and may be heard in either the Beowawe or Eureka department of that Court.

.030 Number of Justices of the Peace

There shall be one Justice of the Peace who shall serve in both departments of the Eureka County Justice Court.

.040 Effective date for consolidated and unified township

The effective date for the consolidation of the Beowawe Justice Court township and the Eureka Justice Court township into the Eureka County Justice Court township shall be effective upon the reduction of the number of active Justices of the Peace to one.

Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption and publication as provided by Nevada Revised Statutes Chapters 244 and 257.

Pursuant to N.R.S. Chapter 237 the following business impact statement is prepared:


1. The proposed ordinance is not likely to impose a direct and significant economic burden upon a business or businesses.
