Minutes

February 25, 2021

A. CALL TO ORDER:

Chair Kersey called the meeting to order at 4:32 p.m. The meeting was held telephonically in accordance with the Governors Directive 006, and subsequent directives throughout the duration of the current State of Emergency. Member Kellerman motioned to approve the agenda; Vice-Chair LaRochelle seconded the motion. Motion carried (3-0).

B. ROLL CALL

Mikayla Kersey, Cindy LaRochelle, Nona Kellerman, and Christina Tucker were present. Jeb Rowley, Public Works Director and Joyce Jeppesen were present via telephone.

C. PUBLIC COMMENT AND DISCUSSION

Member Kellerman stated that Mrs. Sondra "Sonni" Sharkozy had passed away on February 24, 2021.

D. REVIEW MINUTES

Member Kellerman motioned to approve the minutes of February 11, 2021, as written; Vice-Chair LaRochelle seconded the motion. Motion carried (3-0).

E. ITEMIZE BUDGET REQUEST FORM

Vice-Chair LaRochelle motioned to approve the Crescent Valley Town Advisory Board Request Form; Member Kellerman seconded the motion. Motion carried (3-0).

F. CRESCENT VALLEY PARK PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT

Christina Tucker advised that Public Works had cut some of the liner out underneath the swings and adjusted the swing height so that it was less likely for kids to kick the mulch all over the place. She also advised that the mulch was raked over the bare spots.

G. BASEBALL FIELD DUGOUTS

Jeb Rowley advised that Public Works could readdress the ballfield upgrades once teams are organized. He stated it would not be looked at this year as Public Works is working on the pavilion expansion, gazebo repairs, and additional storage at the Senior Center. The funds were allocated a few years ago, and these funds do not rollover from year to year.

I. PUBLIC COMMENT AND DISCUSSION

Member Kellerman stated that the \$ 3,000.00 donation that was received from Nevada Gold Mines was deposited in to the North End Activities Fund.

Joyce Jeppesen stated that today was Kristi Davids last day, and that she had worked for Eureka County for thirteen and one-half years. She started as a janitor and moved into the position of staffing the Public Works office on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Public Works wishes her luck and hopes she has a lot of fun with whatever her plans are. Currently, the Town Hall will be open on Wednesdays from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m., and staff will rotate up from the Eureka office. As always, people can call Eureka or contact Eldon Brown or Christina Tucker.

The Senior Center will resume transportation to Elko; interested individuals must call and sign up as space is limited to 5 riders. Masks will be required to be worn and hand sanitizer will be required after each stop. The Senior Center will also reopen with limited occupancy on March 15, 2021, to diners 65 years of age and older; diners must call to reserve a seat by 9:00 a.m. Meals will still be delivered until the center is open to full capacity.

J. ADJOURNMENT


Member Kellerman motioned to adjourn at 5:03 p.m.; Vice-Chair LaRochelle seconded the motion. Motion carried (3-0).
