

# 2016 Eureka County Fair Frog Jump Contest Rules and Regulations



Sign in begins 15 minutes before scheduled contest time in front of grassy area.

First contest is Friday August 12<sup>th</sup>, 2016 10:00am, and then again at 2:00pm

Second contest is Saturday August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2016 11:00am and then again at 2:00pm

**All frogs are welcome and good care should be top priority!**

**Please keep frogs in a moist container in a shaded area with natural materials such as grass or moist dirt .**

**Handle all racers with care and after their racing day is over return to where he or she calls home!**

1. Frog will be judged on three successive jumps.
2. Child must supply his or her own frog. If catching your frog from the wild, be sure to have permission from property owner/manager before removing frog from habitat.
3. The child has to place the frog at the center of the lilly pad. Frog cannot be touched after placing on starting spot, you may cheer, stomp or slap the ground, clap anything but touching the frog. If touched, the frog will be disqualified.
4. Frogs will have three minutes to complete jump a minimum of three jumps, if not completed by the three minute mark, frogs jump or jumps will be recorded as record.
5. All frogs are invited to attend.
6. Decisions of the judge(s) are final.
7. Open to ages 15 and under.
8. Eureka County Fair has right to change rules as they see fit to see that all children are treated fairly.
9. Winner is determined by the longest total feet and inches a frog jumps during his three minutes or total of three jumps.
10. Entries are open to first 10 sign ups at contest time
11. Only first place will receive prize for each contest.
12. Champion of the frog jump, the top three frogs will have a champion jump off after 2:00pm contest on Saturday August 13<sup>th</sup>. The frog that jumps the longest out of the top three frogs will win a grand prize!
