Eureka County is Seeking Applications for Appointment to the Position of  
**Eureka County Treasurer/Public Administrator/Public Guardian**

The Eureka County Board of Commissioners is accepting letters of interest and application to fill the vacancy of the elected County Treasurer/Public Administrator position, which is combined with the appointed position of Public Guardian. The appointment will be effective July 8, 2019, through January 4, 2021. NRS 245.170 requires that certain vacant elected positions be placed on the next biennial election, which will be in 2020.

This interim position is appointed by the County Commissioners and includes the following benefits: health, vision, dental, life insurance, and PERS. Salary is set by NRS 245.043 and is \$63,965.00 per fiscal year. Applicants must be a qualified elector of Eureka County.

Letters of interest must be submitted to the Comptroller's Office, P.O. Box 852, 10 S. Main Street, Eureka, Nevada, 89316, no later than 5:00 p.m. on June 5, 2019. The Board of County Commissioners will interview candidates and make an appointment at their regularly scheduled meeting on June 6, 2019, and said appointment will be effective July 8, 2019.
